

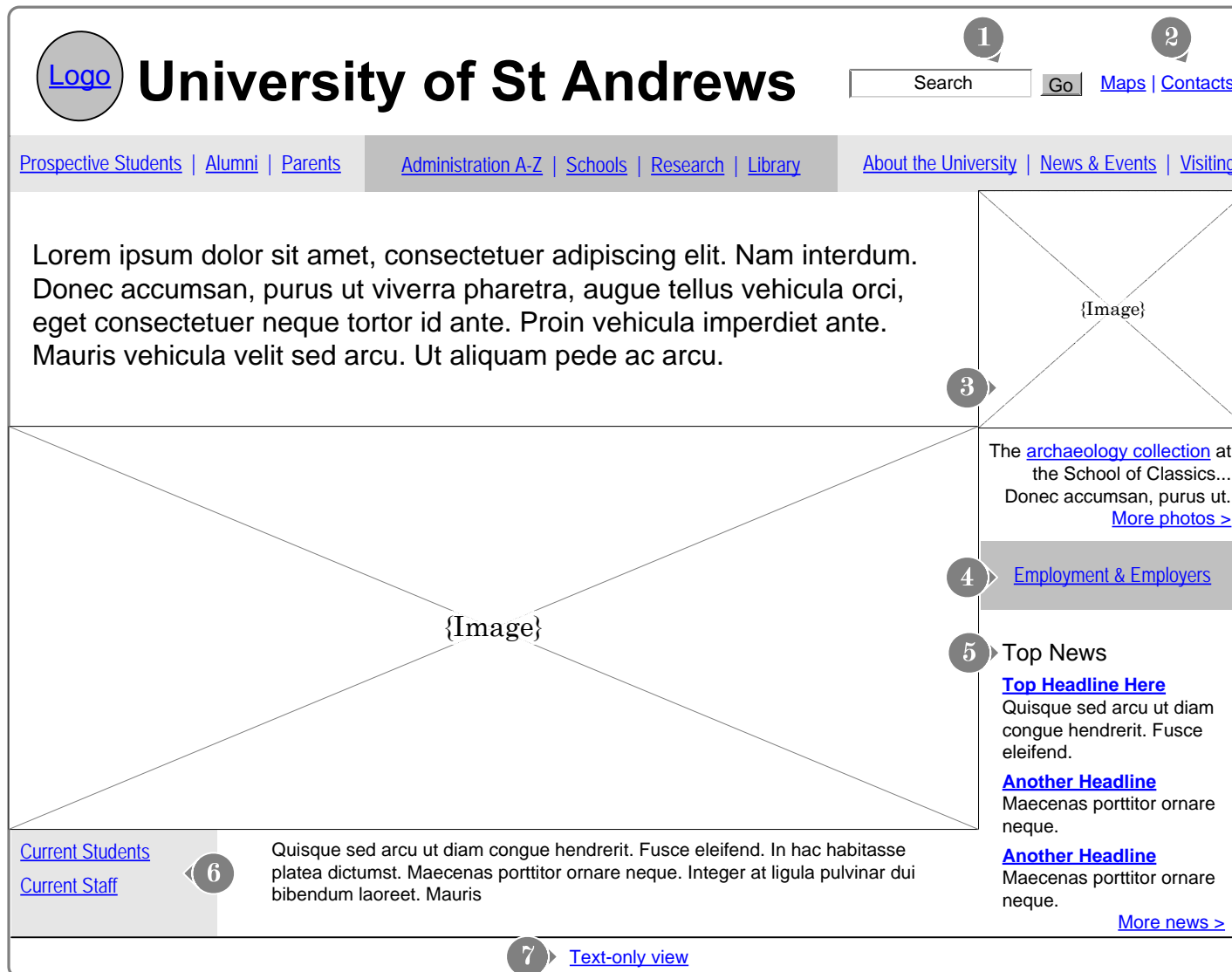

- 1 Because users rarely try advanced search before basic search, advanced search options (filters, boolean operators, etc.) are accessed from the search results page.
- 2 Links to Tools do not interact with the search box or Go button. When the user clicks Maps, the Maps page is displayed. When the user clicks Contacts, the Contacts page is displayed.
- 3 Image of the week (or month) highlights a photo from one of the University's archives. Photo should be changed at regular intervals. "More photos" links to the Photographic Archive page within Library > Museums & Collections.
- 4 Employment & Employers links to the Employment page in the Administration section. The Employment page provides information for job seekers and information for employers seeking to hire students from the University. Note: Information on career counseling for students will be available from the Prospective Students and Current Students sections.
- 5 Top News lists the latest headlines for a set number of news stories. Each headline is accompanied by a short description and the headline links to the story page. "More news" links to the News & Events page.
- 6 Alternate entry points are not a persistent part of the navigation. Job Seekers & Employers links to "Employment" under Administration. Links for Current Staff and Current Students are not available elsewhere on the public site.
- 7 Text-Only View converts the current page to text-only format using the BBC's Betsie Perl script.

- 1 The search box appears in the content area, rather than in the upper-right corner, so the user can refine his or her search more easily.
- 2 Search results appear in the same wrapper as the previous page. Pages listed in search results may be displayed in other wrappers.
- 3 Clicking the Advanced Options link expands advanced search options that appear below the search field and allow the user to refine the search using options offered by the search engine.
- 4 Help opens a new, smaller window that show help for searching and advanced options, e.g., Boolean explanations, tips such as inurl searches, and general tips such as quotation marks in searches.
- 5 The user can sort results by relevance or by date.
- 6 Non-HTML file types are marked by the file extension in brackets at the beginning of the result listing.
- 7 Results in subdirectories of other results are indented.
- 8 The user can page through results and determine the number of results shown per page. A "< Previous" link appears when the user views subsequent results pages. A "Next >" link appears also in the gray bar on top of search results (which changes to "< Previous Next >" on subsequent pages).

- 1** When the user views a News page, he or she can search just news stories or the whole St Andrews website.
- 2** The News & Events section contains secondary navigation for news, events, and related information. Note: The subsection categories presented in this wireframe are intended to be representational.
- 3** The page content begins with a single Featured Story followed by a set number of Recent Stories. The Featured Story should have an accompanying photo image. The user can read more featured stories by clicking the More Featured Stories link, which displays a page listing the last ten or so feature stories.
- 4** Recent Stories is a reverse chronological list of all stories selected to be published at the University level, excepting the current Featured Story (because it's already listed on the page). Older Featured Stories are included in the list of Recent Stories.
- 5** Both the Featured Story and the stories listed under Recent Stories contain the story's title (linked to the full story), a summary of the story, and the date the story was published.
- 6** Stories in the Recent Stories list may or may not contain a thumbnail image of an accompanying photo for the story.
- 7** The user can view the next most recent stories by clicking the Older Stories link on this page. The subsequent page contains just Recent Stories (i.e., no Featured Story in its own area), with a reasonable number of stories per page. Subsequent pages have both an Older Stories link and a Newer Stories link.

Each story page contains the story's title, date of publication, and the body of the story.

2

The user should be able to view a version of the story formatted for printing. The print version opens in a new window, with the title, publications date, text, and photos. The print view comes with a default header and footer containing the University name and logo, along with the URL for the online version of the story.

3

Stories may have one or more photos embedded in the body of the story.

4

At the bottom of every story, Previous Story and Next Story links appear that allow the user to browse the current subsection chronologically by publication date.

Graphic Ad: {featured event graphic ad}
 Explanatory caption for the graphic ad

- 1 When the user views an Events page, he or she can search just events or the whole St. Andrews website.
- 2 The default view is to show all events for the current date, plus following dates (up to 20 plus or minus events (see below)).
- 3 Each day is split into AM and PM listings. If there are no events for AM or PM, that heading does not appear. If there are no events for a date, the date heading should appear with the message “No events.” under the heading.
- 4 The user can show future or past events by clicking a date in the Date Picker control. Only events for the selected date are displayed. In the control, if there are events on a date, an indicator appears in that date’s square (in the example, the indicator is a small triangle in the lower-right corner). The user can click the arrows at the top to change the month.
- 5 The user also can filter by category. The Date Picker and Category filters operate simultaneously (i.e., the user can see events for a specific date within a single category). Note: The categories shown here are representational. If the user clicks a category, an indicator should be displayed for that category.
- 6 The user can click a link to view an event’s details. Note: Event titles might be more legible if the link underline appears only on hover.
- 7 The user can click Previous Events or Next Events to see the next or previous page of events, chronologically. Each page shows about twenty events, with the caveat that each date displayed must show all the events for that date (we don’t want to split a date’s events between pages). If the user has selected a category, the Previous and Next links display events in that category.

- 8 A featured event can be given prominence by creating a graphic ad for the event (e.g., “Commencement 2007 May 24” text on a picture of ecstatic students at graduation ceremonies), along with, when required, a caption that provides additional information. Both the graphic and the caption link to the Event Details page for the event.

- 1 When the user views an Events page, he or she can search just for events or the whole St Andrews website.
- 2 The event's details begins with the event's title followed by its description. The event details are displayed in When, Where, Who, More Info, Contact, and Categories fields. If a field has no data, that field won't appear. Some fields, such as When, require data when an event is submitted.
- 3 The user can view a version of the event formatted for printing. The print version opens in a new window, with the title, description, and details. The print view comes with a default header and footer containing the University name and logo, along with the URL for the online version of the event's Event Details page.
- 4 The highlighted date in the date picker should be the event's date. The user can return to browsing a list of events by clicking the Events link in the left column, clicking a date in the Date Picker control, or clicking a category.
- 5 If the user had previously clicked a category, that selection remains on this page. While an event may appear in different categories, only the category selected by the user appears with an indicator; showing multiple indicators might be confusing. If the user clicks a category or a date from this page, the page refreshes to list events for that category or date.
- 6 At the bottom of the Event Details list, Previous Event and Next Event links appear that allow the user to browse individual events in chronological order. Note: It would be a nice-to-have to customize the Previous and Next links for the selected category, e.g., "Previous Athletics Events."
